HALLOWEEN FIREWORKS

Bylaw No. 05-2010 regulates the possession and discharge of fireworks in the District of Port Hardy.



- A permit must be obtained from the District of Port Hardy for the use of all fireworks including, but not limited to, Class F.1 Consumer Fireworks.
- Consumer fireworks may only be discharged between 5:00p.m. and 10:00p.m. on October 31st (Halloween) with a permit.
- Permit applications must be submitted to the District of Port Hardy no later than noon on October 31st (there is no fee).
- Permit applications for consumer or display fireworks events must be submitted no later than thirty (30) days prior to the date of the event.

**SHAKE OUT BC DAY
OCTOBER 15, 2015**

On October 15th, officially "ShakeOut BC Day," millions of people worldwide will practice how to Drop, Cover, and Hold On at 10:15 am during Great ShakeOut Earthquake Drills!

DROP to the ground (before the earthquake topples you!) Take COVER by getting under a sturdy desk or table, and HOLD ON until the shaking stops.

WHY SHOULD YOU PARTICIPATE???

While potential earthquake hazards depend on your location, everywhere in British Columbia is considered at high risk in relation to the rest of Canada. For example, on January 26, 1700, a magnitude 9 earthquake (similar to the 2011 Tohoku earthquake off the coast of Japan) shook the entire province as well as Washington, Oregon, and California, and generated a massive tsunami.



What we do now will determine our quality of life after our next big earthquake. Are you prepared to survive and recover quickly?

The Great British Columbia ShakeOut is an annual opportunity to practice how to be safer during big earthquakes: "Drop, Cover, and Hold On." The ShakeOut has also been organized to encourage you, your community, your school, or your organization to review and update emergency preparedness plans and supplies, and to secure your space in order to prevent damage and injuries.

Do not cut down greenbelt trees unless you: 1. Have permission from the District Office 2. Have liability insurance coverage 3. Clean up the debris. You can be ticketed \$100 by the District and/or prosecuted in Provincial Court (\$2,000 maximum fine). You could be held liable for restitution for labour, clean up costs and property loss over and above any fine.

DANGER TREES If there are trees on District land that may be dangerous to your home or property, call the Public Works Yard (949-7779) to arrange for an inspection.

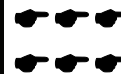

District of Port Hardy - Garbage and Recycling Bylaw No. 1027-2014

Sec. 7. STORAGE OF GARBAGE OR REFUSE

- No person shall store any garbage or trade waste which includes an attractant in such a manner that is accessible to domestic animals or wildlife.
- All garbage that includes an attractant shall be stored in an enclosed building, shed or storage facility or in a locked standard container, and shall not be left in or on any area accessible to domestic animals or wildlife.
- An owner or occupier is exempt from section 7(a) between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on the designated garbage collection day that applies to the street on which their eligible dwelling is located.
