1. Mike DesRochers, Strategic Natural Resource Consultants re: Knotweed Eradication Program Outline.

Mr. DesRochers gave an overview of historical and current the knotweed eradication program on the North Island. He advised:

- the knotweed issue is widespread, ongoing, and needs a long term capacity building eradication plan from North Island communities as well as the Ministry of Transportation and BC Hydro.
- a best practise would be to have municipal workers qualified to administer pesticides on an ongoing basis.
- that the District had previously budgeted \$5,000 and \$5,000 for in kind help for the Regional District of Mount Waddington grant application

M. DESROCHERS STRATEGIC NATURAL RESOURCE CONSULTANTS RE: KNOTWEED ERADICATION PROGRAM

- that that there is 2-3 week window this fall where eradication can still take place using the previously approved funding
- that communication with the Kwakiutl First Nation regarding the eradication program on their traditional lands is important

Council members discussed with Mr. DesRochers:

- the Regional District of Mount Waddington Eradication program grant being resubmitted in the spring
- the short window of the proposed fall eradication program and workers, staff and equipment involved
- · public awareness programs through Forestry week and school visits
- · knotweed sites inventory as an ongoing process

Mayor Bood thanked Mr. DesRochers for his informative presentation.
