RE: Resolution to authorize staff to apply to the Gas Tax Strategic Priorities Fund

PURPOSE

To authorize staff to apply to the Gas Tax Strategic Priorities Fund (SPF) for up to six million dollars towards the funding of the Port Hardy Multiplex project.

ANALYSIS

The SPF program provides grant funding specifically targeted for the capital costs of local government infrastructure projects that are larger in scale, regional in impact, or innovative and support the national objectives of productivity and economic growth, a clean environment and strong cities and communities.

Grant applications must be submitted by June 1, 2017 and projects may include recreational infrastructure. A SPF grant can fund up to 100% of eligible costs of an eligible project up to a maximum federal Gas Tax Fund amount of \$6 million.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

"THAT Council authorize staff to apply to the Gas Tax Strategic Priorities Fund for up to six million dollars towards the Port Hardy Multiplex Project and further authorizes staff to pursue this funding source for any extra funding that may be available for this project".
