Proof of Vaccination Information District of Port Hardy Facilities





Have your vaccine card ready for:

- Indoor ticketed sporting events
- Indoor concerts, theatre, dance and symphony events
- Gyms, exercise facilities/studios, pools and recreation facilities
- Group exercise
- Indoor adult group and team sports for people 22 years old or older
- Indoor organized events with 50 or more people. For example:
 Wedding receptions, organized parties, conferences and workshops
- Indoor organized group recreational classes and activities like pottery, art and choir

Other activities include:

- Licensed restaurants and restaurants that offer table service (indoor and patio dining)
- Pubs, bars and lounges (indoor and patio dining)
- Nightclubs, casinos and movie theatres
- Post-secondary on-campus student housing

Starting September 13, 2021 you must prove your vaccination status as follows:







Please have your vaccine Card <u>and</u> a piece of Valid Government ID, for example:

- B.C. driver's licence or BC Services Card
- Passport
- Photo ID issued by another province or territory

Note: you can use your vaccine card that was issued at the time of your vaccine up until September 26, 2021

You will not need a vaccine card for:

- Indoor organized events with less than 50 people, except adult sports
- Vote in-person in the September 20 federal election or at advance polling places.
- Worship services
- Before and after school programs for K to 12 students
- Indoor youth recreational sport for people 19 years old or younger
- Formal local government business, including by-elections, council/board meetings and public hearings for both council/board members as well as the public attending these events or coming to Municipal Hall on Municipal business.

Other activities include:

- Grocery stores, liquor stores and pharmacies
- Unlicensed restaurants that don't offer table service, like fast food, coffee shops and takeout
- Salons, hairdressers, barbers
- Hotels, resorts, cabins and campsites
- Banks and credit unions, Retail and clothing stores, Food banks and shelters
- Escape rooms, laser tag, indoor paint ball, arcades and bowling alleys (if they are unlicensed or don't offer table service)
- Post-secondary on-campus cafeterias
